


Q1. My child is happy at school and they are very well looked after.


Q2. My child feels safe at school and is taught about safety including e-safety.




Q4. I am happy that my child is learning well. I am aware that I can talk to teachers at any time in the year if I am concerned about any aspect of my child's learning.




# Q5. My child is taught well at this school.




Q6. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.




# Q7. This school makes sure that its pupils are well behaved.




Q9. This school is well led and managed at all levels.




Q10. This school takes any concerns I raise seriously. I am able to speak to staff when I need to.




Q11. I receive information about school activities, the curriculum and changes to things such as assessment.




Q12. The school offers an excellent range of extracurricular activities including after-school care, clubs, arts, music and sports events.
