Lindale C of E Primary School is a kind and warming school located in Grange-Over-Sands. There are fifty-four students (including nursery).

Outstanding Outside Areas

In 2022, there was some new equipment installed (gazebo, weighing scales, pulley bucket on a line, monkey poles, wooden seat, water mover and water run). The gazebo is a big wooden structure at the bottom of the field. Inside the gazebo, there are some comfy beanbags to sit on. The beanbags have pictures of animals on (parrot, mouse, green bug, hedgehog and penguin); the children find them very comfy and colourful. There are also some benches around the side so that when other children are sat down on the beanbags they can wait on the benches for a turn to sit on the beanbags or you can eat your snack on the bench. The gazebo is also a quiet place to sit whilst eating your snack. The weighing scales and pulley rope are two poles with a rope so you can transport rocks and at the end there is a big weighing scale that you can weigh the rock against other different sized rocks; the student enjoy weighing the rocks and other materials. The monkey poles are wooden poles with some grips on and you can climb them and jump to other poles. The children find them very fun to play with as well as their friends. Some of the favourites are the willow dens; they are little dens made of woven willow with some small cushions inside. The students often play hide and seek in them. Around the playground, there are some instruments which make a lot of noise. KS1 enjoy playing with the water run and water mover which are located at the top of the field is the KS1 playground.

Regularly, the school have a value day; the day was about doing activities about the school values. Everyone in school do all the activities and they find it very fun.
